How to Borrow from Warner Library and the WestchesterCountySystem---

from the 'comfort of your own home.'

- 1. Have a valid public library card from Warner library. (KoH library will help you get one if needed.)
- 2. Call Warner PL and ask to be connected with Reference to place a reserve. (914-631-7734) If you are told it is available, ask to have it put in the Kendal Box.
- 3. If you are told you will get a call when your book is available, wait until you get an automated message that your book is ready for pick-up. Then....
- 4. Call Warner (914-631-7734) and ask that it be put in the Kendal Box.
- 5. You will get a call from your Kendal Library when your book is ready for pick-up. You may collect it any weekday between 10 and 12 or between 2 and 4 in the Kendal Library.
- 6. Read and enjoy.
- 7. To return the book put it in the Return box marker 'Warner' or hand it to a Library volunteer.

Simple!

If you would like to place your reserve by computer, go to www.warnerlibrary.org click on Catalog and follow prompts. (Your password is the last 4 numbers of your phone number.) Ask us at Kendal Library for a demonstration if you wish.
